If a pick-up time is not indicated, the default pick up day and time each week will be Wednesdays after 12pm in the big red barn located at 11105 SW Baker Creek Road, McMinnville, OR, 97128. By becoming a member, I commit to picking up my share weekly and I understand that if I, or someone I designate, is unable to pick up my share, it will be donated to the St. Barnabas Soup Kitchen. There will be no refunds or exchanges.
- The remaining balance on your CSA share will be due by July 1st. The amount of produce received by the shareholder will be directly related to their payment. If a member does not pay the full amount by the time indicated, or if at any time during the CSA duration, a member is not current on their payment, the agreement will be terminated and the shareholder will receive an amount of produce equal only to the value of their payment at that time.
